

CHURCH PLANTING IN SIBIU ROMANIA

THE WORK

Raul and Claudia began their ministry in Sibiu, Romania in 2022. January 7th 2024 marked the first public service and official opening of the church.

MAIN GOALS:

I. Plant a new church

IPC Sibiu is the first Presbyterian church in the city and among the very few in Romania. We are a small congregation of seven families but we are grateful for what the Lord worked among us so far and we look with hope towards the future.

II. Build a foundation for future reformed church plants

Even though we are small we have a great and powerful God.

There are very few reformed churches in Romania and our hope is that this will change in the future. We hope to build relationships and bridges with other congregations, produce materials (translate and publish books, manuals, videos etc.), train future church planters and provide a foundation on which others can build upon.

III. Work for the Kingdom

Although we have firm Reformed Presbyterian beliefs, we want to serve Christs church to the best of our abilities. We provide biblical counseling and counseling trainings to the broader evangelical community, we invest in Christian education and we hold camps and conferences throughout the country.

What defines Romanians?

Romania is an Eastern European country that was part of the communist bloc for many years, which still leaves visible traces in contemporary society.

Obstacles for the gospel

The main challenges are a growing destain of the population for all things religious and christian due to the excesses of the Orthodox Church and second the growing Western hedonistic secular influences.

Open doors for the gospel

The families and members of the church practice day to day evangelism, sharing the gospel where God placed them, at work, at school and in their families.

The counselling ministry that the church provides reaches many unbelievers. There is a growing comunity of internationals and students that we want to share the gospel with. We also have an educational center and we use it to disciple families and children and promote christian education.
